Changes to Microsoft 365 Licencing

Microsoft have announced a change in the way 365 licences are provisioned as part of their new pricing structure, as of 1st March 2022.

You will already have been made aware of the new price increases coming into effect from this date.

This leaves our customers with two choices:

ANNUAL AGREEMENT CONTRACT

- The **NEW** price is fixed until **28th February 2023**.
- The number and type of licences you hold currently will be fixed throughout the 12 month period.
- You can **ADD** licences at any point during the year, but you **CANNOT** remove licences.
- You have a '72 Hour Window' at your Contract **ANNUAL** anniversary, to make any significant changes for the following 12 months.

MONTHLY ROLLING CONTRACT

- The pricing is **NOT** fixed and can change at any given point.
- We are aware there is another price increase due **1st July 2022**.
- You can **ADD** licences at any point in the month.
- You have a '72 Hour Window' **EACH** month to **REMOVE** licences.
- If you foresee a lot of fluctuations in your requirements over the forthcoming months, then a monthly rolling provision may be better for you.
